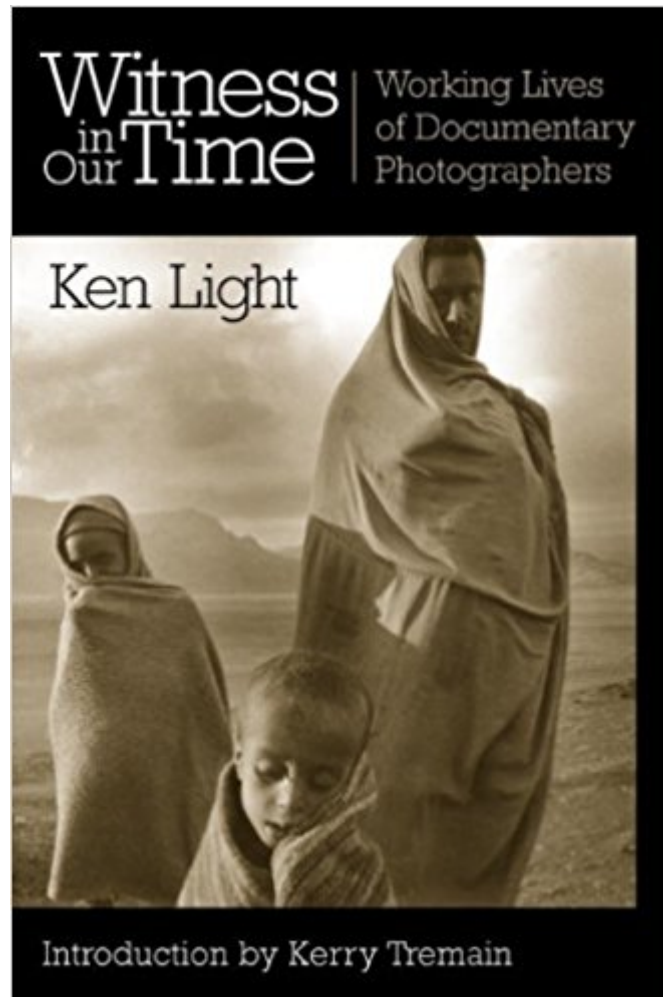

This is a great book. If you are at all interested in documentary photography/photojournalism, then you will not be able to put this book down! It is jam-packed with a collection of personal essays by the world's most prominent documentary photographers. They speak about why and how they do what they do, their path in life and their experiences seeing the world up close and personal. The book has at least one black and white image example per photographer, but it's not a coffee table photography book. It's a relatively small size and can be carried with you in a bag quite easily. I'm going to go back and read this book again. It is full of reasonings and inspirations and as a published photographer, it makes me want to grab my Leica and hit the streets with some black and white film...

This will be the second time I'm buying this book. I've lent it out to one of my staff and somewhere down the line it's disappeared. I think that says a lot about this book. It's nice to have around to read through on a Saturday morning with a mug of coffee or flip through for inspiration. It has definitely helped not only the way I see the world, but with my own photography.

This book is a great addition to my photography library. The photos demonstrate great use of natural light available at the time of the photograph. I would recommend it for any expert or novice photographer.
